- 4. Last warning meeting with parent, camper may be suspended for 1 day
- 5. If camper's behavior does not improve, ultimately camper may be asked to withdraw from camp.

***For Fighting-One warning will be given when we are explaining the rules of camp, any fighting may warrant an instant dismissal from camp. Valuables and Electronics should be left at home.
